From the North:- M6 junction 36. Take the 1st turning left onto A65 then follow the above directions.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

- The committee will not be responsible for or liable for any loss or damage sustained by the exhibitors, riders or their horses or ponies and all entries are accepted on this basis.
- The organiser reserves the right to cancel or amalgamate any classes if there are insufficient entries.
- Entries will not be accepted without the appropriate fee and must reach the secretary on or before 7th May 2026. LATE ENTRIES DOUBLE FEE (less the Levy).
- Except for the RIHS qualifying classes you do not need to be a member of the BSPS.
- The organisers have tried to ensure that classes do not clash, however, it is the responsibility of the competitors to ensure they can compete in the classes entered.
- The committee will have the power to judge any dispute that may arise, their decision will be final. Any objection to the result of any class must be made in writing to the secretary within 30minutes of the completion of the class. A deposit of £5.00, returnable if the objection is sustained must accompany the objection.
- All entry fees are non-returnable. Prize money will be paid on the day. No substitutions will be allowed. RI Classes £15, 10, 5 all other classes £5, £4, £2
- This show is a qualifier for the RIHS. Only one pony in each of the Open Ridden Show Pony, L/R SHP, FR SHP, Open SHP, Pretty Polly SP, SHP, and Heritage ridden, Intermediate Show Hunter, Riding Horse & Hack Type, Cradle & Nursery Stakes, Open WHP and Intermediate WH, Heritage Ridden and L/R & F/R, Young Dragonnara & Anglo and part bred Arab classes qualify. The highest placed (not already qualified) from the first three ponies placed in each class will qualify. Owners and riders must be BSPS members and the pony registered with the BSPS to compete in these classes. All qualifying entries for the RIHS must be delivered or sent on or before the closing date, together with the amount of entry fee and charges required. Late entries will only be accepted from qualifiers at those show's which are held after the closing date of entry.
- This show is affiliated to the BSPS (no:839) and all persons competing or otherwise taking part in BSPS classes whether or not members of the BSPS are subject to the constitution and rules of the BSPS including disciplinary procedures, and shall be deemed to have consented to the jurisdiction of the BSPS. Any pony taking part in classes judged under BSPS rules will be liable to dope testing.
- This show is a qualifier for the BSPS Championship Show held at the Arena UK. All ponies must be registered in accordance with rule 21 & 26 and ridden by a BSPS member to qualify.
- Only horses and ponies competing in the current and following classes will be allowed in the collecting rings at any time.
- **BSPS CLASSES WILL BE REQUIRED TO ADHERE TO RULES 43 & 50 IN THE 2025 BSPS RULEBOOK WITH REGARD TO HAT TAGGING & BODY PROTECTORS.**
- The RIHS levy is £12 per entry. Owners and riders must be BSPS members and the Pony registered with the BSPS to compete in classes with qualification for the RIHS. Animals to be registered with AHS for classes 39.
- "Neither the BSPS or any of its officers, assistants or stewards shall in any way be responsible for any loss, injury or damages that may happen to exhibitors or their assistants or other members of the public, or to any animal or property or to any vehicle brought into the Showground or on any premises used in conjunction with the Show, or while entering or leaving the same.
- It is necessary all exhibitors carry Public Liability Insurance for an adequate Indemnity to protect horses and riding at any standard has inherent risk and that all horses may react unpredictably on occasions. You may fall off and could be injured, or be injured by another horse. By entering you accept these risks. It is advisable you take out your own Personal Accident insurance to cover you against the risks of injury."

RIDING HORSE, COBS & HACKS

Held under the rules of the British Show Horse Association. Horses must be registered with the Association and all Owners, Exhibitors, Producers and Riders must be Association Members. Riders must be 15 years of age or older. Registration numbers must be quoted on entry form.

Classes **62-63, 65-67, 69-70** are qualifiers for The Royal International Horse Show. The first prize winner will qualify to compete at the final. If already qualified the second will qualify, if the first and second are already qualified then the third will go forward.

Horses competing **at the RIHS and qualifying shows in Hunter sections of The Sport Horse Breeding of Great Britain** at their Affiliated Shows cannot compete in Hack, **Cobs** and Riding Horse classes at the same show, **and vice versa**. This does not apply to SHB (GB) Ridden Sport Horse classes.

The highest placed unqualified prize winners in each **Open** Affiliated classes will qualify to compete in the BSHA Classic Supreme of the year final. The Finals will be held at the BSHA Hunter & National Championship Show in September 2026

The BSHA offer a Novice, Young Rider and Amateur rosette in each Open class and a Champion rosette for each section.

DAY TICKETS

Non-Members may purchase up to a maximum of 2 Day Tickets and two Show Tickets per Exhibitor, per Horse, per Rider, per season. A Day Ticket will allow entry into Amateur, Home Produced, In-Hand, Novice, Working, Young Rider, and Open Affiliated classes only, but will NOT allow entry into RIHS or HOYS qualifying classes (except RIHS Amateur Classes & RIHS Working Show Horse Class). A Show Ticket has the same criteria and covers all days of a Show running for longer than one day. Horses registered on a Day / Show Ticket do not require a JMB height certificate. Competitors can apply for a Day / Show Ticket by applying online on the BSHA website.

For the RIHS qualification, the highest placed unqualified in the top 5 will qualify. For the SEIB Working Show Horse qualification, the two highest placed unqualified in the top 5 will qualify. RIHS Qualifying classes held after 1st August will carry the qualification forward to 2027, but only the WINNER will receive qualification in these cases.

Open **ONLY** to Hacks, Cobs, Maxi Cobs and Riding Horses, mare or gelding four years old and over, exceeding 148cms. This class is **NOT** open to Hunters, ie those horses registered and competing as a hunter or working hunter with BSHA, Sport Horse Breeding of Great Britain or The Showing Register for the current season.

Please refer to rule 2(iv) in the 2026 BSHA Rulebook.

The Working Show Horse qualifying classes may be entered on a day ticket, but appropriate membership and horse registration must be applied for within 14 days of the qualifier in order to confirm qualification.

Any Horse which is a Grade B Showjumper, Intermediate Eventer, or above, as at the 1st January of the current year, is not eligible to compete in any Working Show Horse class. A Rider may ride up to two Horses in the jumping phase but must then select one Horse to take through to the Ride and Conformation phases (if required). No change of Rider is allowed.

HUNTER CLASSES SPORT HORSE BREEDING of GREAT BRITAIN

QUALIFICATION FOR THE ROYAL INTERNATIONAL HORSE SHOW – RIDDEN HUNTERS

This Show is a Qualifier for the 2026 Royal International Horse Show to be held at the All-England Course, Hickstead, Sussex in July 2026. Competitors qualifying at this show for the Longines Royal International Horse Show July 2026 must submit their entries online within 48 hours of qualifying.

All Hunter Classes will be judged under the 2026 Rules of the Sport Horse Breeding of Great Britain. Classes 70-72, 74-75, are qualifying events for the 2026 R.I.H.S. and only horses Registered on the 2026 Show Hunter Register are eligible to enter. REGISTRATION numbers MUST be quoted on entry forms & owners & members must be members of the society. Amateur Hunter Classes 71-72 In the Lightweight section, the two highest placed smalls and the two highest placed lightweights will qualify and in the heavyweight section the two highest placed middleweights and the two highest placed heavyweights will qualify. REFER TO 2026 RULEBOOK FOR NEW AMATEUR STATUS RULING FOR THE CURRENT YEAR

Classes horses need to be on SHB(GB) basic id or passports over stamped by SHB(GB) & owners & riders current members of SHB(GB) or can apply for day ticket.

Day Ticket = £45 (this entitles competitors to compete at a maximum of 2 show in the year at £45 per show– it covers owners and rider membership together with horse registration for that show)

In the working Hunter Classes the three highest placed horses will qualify unless they have already done so. No horse lower than third will qualify. If there is a working hunter championship made up of the first & second prize winners from the light & heavyweight working hunter Classes respectively, these four horses will qualify for RIHS, unless they have already done so.

In relation to Headwear - It is strongly recommended that competitors aged 18 or over wear correctly secured Skull Caps/Riding Hats that meet one of the following current Safety Standards: All PAS015, VG1, (BS) EN 1384 2017, ASTM F1163 04a onwards, SNELL E2001, AS/NZS 3838 2003 onwards. Hats should have a plain cover, and may be black, navy blue or grey. Velvet covers are encouraged. It is mandatory for competitors under the age of 18 to wear such skull caps or hats. In the jumping phase of working hunter classes the aforementioned skull caps/riding hats must be worn.

ANY COMPETITOR NOT ADHERING TO THIS WILL BE ASKED TO LEAVE THE RING/CLASS.

Class 70 RIHS Small Hunter mare or gelding, 4 years and over exceeding 148cms (14.2hh) not
Entry Fee exceeding 158cms (15.2hh).

Animals in ridden height restricted classes WILL NOT be required to be in possession of a JMB Height certificate or verification of measurement to compete in RIHS or HOYS Qualifiers. However qualifying animals will need to be measured WITHIN 28 DAYS OF QUALIFICATION OR BEFORE THE FINAL, WHICHEVER IS SOONER. The valid JMB full height certificate or a valid JMB annual height certificate must be submitted to the SHB (GB) office on receipt from the JMB and prior to competing at RIHS. There are NO exceptions to this rule.

Class 71 RIHS Lightweight Amateur Hunter mare or gelding, 4 years and over capable of carrying
Entry Fee up to 12st. 7lbs. (79.5kgs). The first two Small Hunters and First two Lightweight Hunters to
£40 qualify for RIHS. To be ridden by an amateur (see 2026 SHB (GB) Rules & Regulations regarding Amateur Status).

Class 72 RIHS Heavyweight Amateur Hunter Mare or gelding, 4 years old or over. Capable of
Entry Fee carrying over 79.5Kgs (12 stone 7lbs). Middleweight Hunters' to be included in this

Class 73 NOVICE WORKING HUNTER (run under 2026 SHB(GB) rules) A mare, gelding or stallion
Entry Fee Stallions, Mares or Geldings (competing stallions must have a red, white and blue ribbon
£15 displayed in their tail), four years old or over, exceeding 148cm (14.2hh approx), not
having won three affiliated Novice working classes or three affiliated Open working
classes before 1st January in the current year. OR, not having been placed 1-9 in ANY
WORKING HUNTER CLASS at Royal International Horse Show or Horse of the Year Show
before 1st January in the current year.

Horses that have more than 5 BE points or 200 BS points, at home or equivalent abroad before 1st January in the current year are not eligible to compete in novice working classes. Height of jumps will not exceed 1.00m (3ft 3 inches.)
Horses entered in these classes must be registered (passported or overstamped) with SHB(GB) and owners and riders must be members of SHB(GB), or compete on a Day Ticket.

Class 74 RIHS Lightweight Working Hunter Mare, gelding or stallion, 4 years old or over,
Entry Fee exceeding 148cms capable of carrying 14 stone and under. Small Hunters to be
£40 included in this category

Class 75 RIHS Heavyweight Working Hunter Mare, gelding or stallion, 4 years old or over,
Entry Fee exceeding 158cms capable of carrying over 14 stone. Middleweight Hunters to be
£40 included in this category.

Failure to jump in the correct section will result in elimination. Grade A Show Jumpers and Advanced Event horses are not eligible to compete in these classes. Any horse which has qualified as a Grade A Show Jumper or Advanced Event Horse as at the 1st January in the current year is not eligible to compete in Working Hunter Classes (2024).

The Maximum total points available is 100. This is made up of: Jumping points = Max 40 points, Style & Performance whilst Jumping = Max 20 points, Ride = Max 20 points, Conformation = Max 20 points.

Fences to be a minimum of 8 and a maximum of 12 in number and a maximum height of 1.14m (3ft 9ins) at the discretion of the Judges. Fences should have a natural appearance and not be easily dislodged. No un-numbered obstacle can be included in the course. The manner of going to be taken into account. No change of rider or tack will be allowed (unless a horse is ridden under side-saddle, in which case, in order to allow the judge to ride, the saddle may be changed for the riding phase only). A rider can ride up to two horses in the jumping phase but then must select only one horse to take forward into the ride and conformation section if so required (no change of rider is allowed). A skull cap or hat and safety harness according to the current approved BSI or European Standard must be worn by ALL competitors in the jumping phase of Working Hunter Classes. Skull caps must have a navy blue or black cover. No hind boots or bandages of any description are allowed in the collecting ring, warm up or in the actual class. On completion of the jumping phase ALL CLEAR ROUNDS and any other horses the judges may require should be asked to return to the ring. If a horse positively stops, ceases to go forwards at any time during its jumping round, or turns its quarters to a fence, or has a complete turnaround, these constitute refusals. If a horse jumps the incorrect fence out of a pen or lane will be eliminated. Horses displaying continued disobedience, or horses leaving the ring whether mounted or dismounted will be eliminated.

Penalties:

First Refusal 15

Second Refusal 20

Third Refusal Elimination
Jumping Knockdown 10 (BS Rules apply for the definition of a knockdown)
Fall of horse or Rider Elimination

Horses with minus scores may not be required for the second phase of the class at the discretion of the judge. Under no circumstances should a horse with a minus score be in a qualifying position. Horses must not be ridden by the Judge in the same ring and at the same time as other horses are jumping. Suitable fences of natural appearance must be available. Judges will not jump horses in Working Hunter Classes. 40 points are awarded for Ride/Manners and Conformation. If there are two judges, Judge A awards a maximum score of 20 for Ride/Manners, Judge B awards a maximum score of 20 for conformation. In the event of a tie in marks, the conformation mark will take precedence, followed by the ride mark, followed by the style mark. Judges should satisfy themselves that the course and fences are in keeping with the Society's recommendations, and Shows should allow time for this. Working Hunter courses are not to be walked by competitors until the judge has given permission. There must be a change of course between Novice, Restricted Open and Open Working Hunter classes.
